DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From East or West, I-40 to Exit 24, Lake Junaluska/Hot Springs. At end of exit take Hwy 209 South (Crabtree Road). Proceed approximately 2 miles; cross a large concrete bridge, and the Arena is on your left. **From the South**, take the Great Smoky Mountain Expressway (Hwy 23/74) to Exit 104 (East Waynesville/Hot Springs/Lake Junaluska). At the end of exit ramp, turn left onto Hwy 209 (Crabtree Road) headed north. Proceed approximately 1 mile; arena will be on your right.

Note: There is construction at Exit 104, so these directions may change slightly.

The area has many fast food chain restaurants, but the best dining options are locally owned and unique. There will be a map and listing of local restaurants on display at the trial site to help you make a choice.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under 4 months of age are strictly prohibited from the grounds.
- The trial-giving club, the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of "Regulations for Agility Trials".
- **Bitches in season and injured dogs are not eligible to compete.** Bitches in season and injured dogs may be withdrawn and the entry fee returned (less \$2.50/run bitches in season, less \$6.00/run injured dogs = our direct costs) upon request of the competitor. Requests must be made no later than Thursday, Sept. 22 at 6 pm. and **must be accompanied by a veterinarian's statement.**
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be made on official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules.** No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: These trials are open to all dogs 15 months of age or older, that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained AKC ILP, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners Listing numbers, or are approved FSS breeds. Dogs with a PAL/ILP or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate. For copies of the Regulations for Agility Trials, write AKC, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390 or call (919) 233-9767.

MOVE-UPS: **Move-up requests for Friday must be made in writing and must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, September 18, 2017 at 6 pm. They may be emailed to jhabbot@charter.net.** Provide dog's call name, owner's name, original class entered and new class requested. Move-ups for Saturday and Sunday must include the above information and be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site by 15 minutes after the close of each day's trial. Dogs moved up will generally be placed at the end of the running order.

CONFIRMATIONS: If you provide an email address, final confirmation of your entry and a judging schedule will be sent to the email address provided—you will NOT receive a confirmation via US mail. If you do not provide an email address, your confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be mailed to the address provided on your entry form. Initial confirmations are sent within 48 hours of receiving entries; final confirmations go out shortly after closing. **If you have not received a copy of your confirmations, contact the secretary; and PLEASE make sure the email address is on your approved senders list.**

AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. New Title rosettes will be awarded; check with the ribbons table for info. MACH and PACH ribbons and MACH and PACH bars will be awarded to dogs who earn these titles at this trial.

MEASURING: Effective 1-1-2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Dogs without a valid jump height card/form may still compete, but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class. This measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. Dogs entered in the 24" or 26" height division are excepted from this requirement. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present, ALL dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure before the dog's first run of the trial. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running, and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. Judging will not be held up or interrupted for measuring! Please see "Instructions" section of entry form.**

HOW TO ENTER THE TRIAL

Use the official entry form that accompanies this premium. Be sure you include the correct amount of money. Checks should be made out to WCDFFA. **PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE** your check to the entry form. Entry fees of \$17 for the dog's first entry per day and \$17 for each of the same dog's additional entries per day include AKC recording fees of \$3.50 for each first entry of each dog each day and \$3.00 for each additional entry of same dog each day. A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with entries of more than 10 dogs and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned. If you include a **legible** email address, we will notify you of the acceptance status of your entry. **Make sure trial secretary's email address is added to your approved senders list.** Dogs may not switch between Regular and Preferred classes within the weekend.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 20% online entries (132 runs/trial day) and 80% paper entries (528 runs/trial day). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Hand deliveries will not be accepted during the first 24 hours following the trial's opening.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
